ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Robert E. Kerivan, doing business as K & W Trucking Co. possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Paramount, California.

K & W Trucking Co. has not filed with the Commission annual reports for the years 1971 and 1972. Moreover, the 1970 annual report forms filed with this Commission state that no operating revenue for public utility warehousing was received during the stated year.

K & W Trucking Co. not having filed the annual reports as required by Section 584 of the Public Utilities Code and General Order No. 104-A, and apparently no longer operating as a public utility warehouseman, the Commission finds that such circumstances constitute good cause for revocation of the prescriptive operative right and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.




IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Robert E. Kerivan, doing business as K & W Trucking Co. as determined by the Commission's order dated July 5, 1960, in Case No. 6587, is hereby revoked.
2. Robert E. Kerivan, doing business as K & W Trucking Co., Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1 (Warehouse), is hereby cancelled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Robert E. Kerivan, doing business as K & W Trucking Co., or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof unless, before such effective date, there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
