
ORDER OF DISMISSAL


By Application to Transfer filed on June 19, 1972, applicants request authority for Cecil R. White, doing business as White & Best Moving & Storage, to transfer a household goods carrier permit and Charles N. White to acquire such permit. By letter dated May 21, 1973, Charles N. White, having failed to pass the examination required by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, requested that the application be dismissed so the permit can be transferred to another party.


Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 53971 is dismissed.
