## ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Mingle Transportation & Warehouse Co., a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Fresno. The Commission has been advised by the warehouseman's tariff agent that it has not performed any public utility warehousing for several years. A review of the utility's annual reports on file with the Commission reveals no warehouse public utility operating income for the years 1971 and 1972.

Since Mingle Transportation & Warehouse Co. is not operating as a public utility warehouseman, the Commission finds that such circumstance constitutes good cause for revocation of the prescriptive operative right and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Mingle Transportation & Warehouse Co., a corporation, as determined by the Commission's order dated August 30, 1960, in Case No. 6903, is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Mingle Transportation & Warehouse Co., a corporation, from California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 52, Cal.P.U.C. No. 224, on file with

the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order and on not less than 10 days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Mingle Transportation & Warehouse Co., a corporation, or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof unless, before such effective date, there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
