ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 80519 dated September 19, 1972, in Application 53254, Arrow Charter Lines, Inc., was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers between Orange Shopping Center, City of Orange, and Litton Industries, Culver City.

This Commission has received a letter dated August 17, 1973 from James H. Lyons, attorney for the carrier requesting that the passenger stage operating authority of Arrow Charter Lines, Inc., be revoked because the authority given the carrier for this route concerns specifically the Culver City location of Litton Industries and said authority no longer appears appropriate in view of the discontinuance of that company's facility.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision No. 80519 in Application No. 53254 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Arrow Charter Lines, Inc., are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Arrow Charter Lines, Inc. at 311 Marbrisa Avenue, Huntington Park, CA 90255, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
