OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 81149 dated March 13, 1973 in this proceeding, Morosa Bros. Transportation Co. was granted interim authority to depart from the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 for the transportation of fiberglass matting from Owens Corning Company, Santa Clara, to Consolidated Fiberglass Products, Bakersfield. The authority was scheduled to expire on September 13, 1973 but was extended until March 15, 1974 by Decision No. 81669 dated July 31, 1973.

By letter dated October 10, 1973, applicant requested withdrawal of Application No. 53835. The letter states in part that the projected movement has not materialized and that Consolidated Fiberglass is purchasing required material from out of state.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Application No. 53835 is dismissed.
2. The interim authority granted by Decision No. 81149 and extended by Decision No. 81669 is canceled.
