ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

L. E. Grainger possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Stockton.

The 1970, 1971 and 1972 annual reports of L. E. Grainger indicate that no revenue from public utility warehouse operations was received for public utility storage at the above location.

Jack L. Dawson, Tariff Agent for L. Z. Grainger, has informed the Commission, pursuant to staff investigation of the matter, that public warehouse operations have not been conducted at the aforementioned location during the past three or four years. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the warehouse operative right should be revoked and that tariffs applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by L. E. Grainger as determined by Decision No. 61667 dated March 14, 1961, in Case No. 6911 is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of L. E. Grainger from the tariffs of California Warehouse Tariff Bureau on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order on not less that ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon L. Z. Grainger or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the effective date hereof unless, before such effective date, there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
