ORDER TERMINATING PROCEEDINGS

Decisions Nos. 81440 and 81441 dated May 30, 1973 extended to November 30, 1973 the interim authority granted to Apex Bulk Commodities and Pyramid Commodities, respectively, to assess less than minimum rates for the transportation of limestone and soda ash, subject to a review at a public hearing.

Applicants' attorney was requested in writing and by telephone to indicate the date that applicants would be ready to present evidence at a public hearing in support of a continuation of the interim authority granted to applicants. Inasmuch as the

Commission has received no response from applicants' attorney, the attorney was informed by letter from the Commission's Secretary that it would be recommended to the Commission that the interim authorities should be terminated.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the interim authority granted to Apex Bulk Commodities in Decision No. 81440 in Application No. 53616 and to Pyramid Commodities in Decision No. 81441 in Application No. 53632 shall terminate on November 30, 1973 and the further relief sought in said applications is denied.
