ORDER TERMINATING PROCEEDINGS

In the captioned proceedings applicants have been granted interim authority, pending hearing, to charge less than the established minimum rates for the transportation of silica sand and related commodities for various shippers. The interim rate authorities (except Application No. 53723), initially scheduled to expire March 1, 1973, were extended until further order of the Commission by Decision No. 81087 dated February 23, 1973.

Each of the applications seek authority to transport silica sand for various glass manufacturers from the Mission Viejo production plant of Owens-Illinois, Inc. near the city of San Juan Bautista. By letter to the Commissson dated May 1, 1973, Mr. D. M. Enos, Director of Purchasing and Traffic, Pacific Region of Owens-Illinois, Inc., advised that the Mission Viejo plant had temporarily ceased operations for an estimated one-year period.¹/ It now appears that the Mission Viejo plant will not be in operation for at least the full period estimated in Mr. Enos' letter referred to above and more likely will not be in full operation for a longer period of time.

The applications have been on file with the Commission for periods in excess of one year and the cost data and other factual information supplied therein are no longer up to date and do not reflect current operating conditions. No transportation of silica sand has been performed under the interim authorities.

In the circumstances the Commission concludes that no useful regulatory purpose would be served by continuing the captioned applications in effect.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the less than minimum rate authorities granted in the following decisions are terminated on the effective date of this order:
