AMENDATORY ORDER

The Commission having issued on October 30, 1973, Decision No. 82077, which provided for tariff filings by respondents in accordance with General Order No. 96-A, it appearing that 30 days' notice requirement of General Order No. 96-A is inconsistent with the provisions of Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision No. 82077 which specifies certain actions to take place on November 6, 1973 and November 26, 1973, and it appearing appropriate to eliminate such inconsistency by amending said Decision No. 82077, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 82077 is amended by adding the following sentence, "The revised tariffs authorized herein shall become effective on the day of filing or after the effective date hereof, whichever is later."

The Commission's Secretary shall mail a copy of this decision to each respondent herein.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
