## ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 81357

By Decision No. 81357 dated May 8, 1973, Commander Industries, Inc. (Commander) was directed to collect \$14,019.67 in undercharges from six respondent shippers, including \$1,502.93 in undercharges from The Key Corporation, and to pay a fine in the amount of the undercharges plus a punitive fine of \$1,000. The entire fine of \$15,019.67 was paid by the respondent carrier on June 27, 1973 at which time it informed the Commission that The Key Corporation had gone into bankruptcy and that it had filed a claim for the \$1,502.93 in undercharges in the bankruptcy proceeding. By letter dated October 11, 1973, Commander informed the Commission that the final and entire payment on its claim for \$1,502.93 in the bankruptcy proceeding amounted to \$100.80 and requested that the fine imposed on it by Decision No. 81357 be reduced by \$1,402.13, the difference between the two amounts. A copy of the receiver-trustee's check for the \$100.80 is attached to the letter. We are of the opinion that the request should be granted and that \$1,402.13 should be refunded to Commander.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The amount of undercharges Commander Industries, Inc. is directed to collect from The Key Corporation by Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision No. 81357 is reduced from \$1,502.93 to \$100.80.
- 2. The \$15,019.67 fine imposed on Commander Industries, Inc. by Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 81357 is reduced by \$1,402.13 to \$13,617.54.
- 3. The Secretary of the Commission is directed to refund to Commander Industries, Inc. \$1,402.13 of the fine paid by it pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 81357.
- 4. In all other respects, Decision No. 81357 shall remain in full force and effect.
