SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 81894 dated September 14, 1973 authorized the Southern Pacific Transportation Company to construct an industrial spur track at grade across Industrial Avenue in the City of Roseville, County of Placer, to be identified as Crossing No. C-109.42-C, with protection to be two Standard No. 9 flashing light signals with automatic gates (General Order No. 75-C).

The Southern Pacific Transportation Company, by letter of October 15, 1973, File No. 92171/349-1, states that it will be unable to install the flashing light signals with automatic gates for about six months. In order to provide track service to American Olean Tile Company as soon as possible, it requests authority to make switching movements across the crossing prior to the completion of the installation of flashing light signals with automatic gates and proposes that the crossing be protected by two Standard No. 1R signs and a member of the crew when such switching movements are made.

The Commission staff has reviewed the railroad's request and it appears reasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that for a period not to exceed six months protection may be as follows:

1. Two Standard No. 1R signs (General Order No. 75-C).

2. No train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossing unless said train, engine, motor or car shall be first brought to a stop and vehicular traffic on Industrial Avenue protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee acting as a flagman.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. In all other respects Decision No. 81394 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
