ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The order instituting this investigation, issued October 24, 1973, required that all interested parties file written comments on the proposed General Order within sixty days of the effective date of the order. Because the sixtieth day will fall on December 24, 1973 the interested parties requested that the time for filing written comments be extended for a reasonable period of time.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that paragraph 3 of the Order Instituting Investigation is amended as follows:

3. Respondents and all interested parties are invited to submit written comments on the proposed General Order, attached hereto as Appendix C, within eighty (80) days after the effective date of this order. These comments must clearly identify those sections of the proposed General Order being

commented upon and should affirmatively recommend alternatives to those sections being criticized.
