ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Santa Rosa Ice & Cold Storage Co., a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Santa Rosa.

Santa Rosa Ice & Cold Storage Co. has not filed with the Commission any annual reports since 1969 and is not currently operating a public warehouse.

Santa Rosa Ice & Cold Storage Co. not having filed the annual reports as required by Section 584 of the Public Utilities Code and General Order No. 104-A, the Commission finds that such circumstances constitute good cause for revocation of the operative right and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Santa Rosa Ice & Cold Storage Co., a corporation, as determined by the Commission's order dated August 9, 1960, in Case No. 6759 is hereby revoked.

2. Santa Rosa Ice & Cold Storage Co. Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, is hereby cancelled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Santa Rosa Ice & Cold Storage Co. or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof unless, before such effective date, there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
