ORDER TERMINATING PROCEEDING

Austin-Laws Truck Lines, Inc., a highway permit carrier, was granted interim authority by Decision No. 81596 dated July 17, 1973 to transport silica sand from Oceanside to the City of Industry for Owens-Illinois, Inc. (Libbey Products Division). The interim authority was granted for a six-month period and was subject to review at a public hearing.

By letter dated November 2, 1973, applicant's counsel advised as follows:

"Hearings on the above application are scheduled to commence on November 12, 1973. On behalf of applicant it is respectfully requested that the application be dismissed at this time without prejudice to the applicant filing a later application."

In the circumstances, the interim relief granted to applicant should be rescinded and the proceeding should be terminated.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that on the effective date of this order the interim relief granted in Decision No. 81596 is rescinded and Application No. 53857 is terminated.
