OPINION

Bernard Shapiro seeks authority to control M.A.P. Warehouse and Trucking Company.

Applicant, Bernard Shapiro, is the sole shareholder of Service Truck Co., a California corporation incorporated on July 27, 1960, and operating as a highway common carrier in the Los Angeles Basin Territory. In addition, the corporation operates under the jurisdiction of this Commission as a highway contract carrier and a radial highway common carrier, and also performs operations subject to the jurisdiction of the Interstate Commerce Commission. Applicant's reported net worth as of October 30, 1973, amounts to \$345,500.

M.A.P. Warehouse and Trucking Company is a California corporation incorporated on December 18, 1972. It operates under the jurisdiction of this Commission as a public utility warehouseman in Los Angeles, and also as a radial highway common carrier.

After consideration, the Commission finds that control of M.A.P. Warehouse and Trucking Company by Bernard Shapiro would not be adverse to the public interest. On the basis of this finding we conclude that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Bernard Shapiro may control M.A.P. Warehouse and Trucking Company.
