The Commission on November 23, 1973 received a written request by letter dated November 21, 1973 from Francis H. Ferraro, Exhibit No. 13 herein, for a further extension of time of one year of the final date of December 11, 1973 by which compliance with ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 73361, issued herein on November 21, 1967, may be completed.

In said letter Mr. Ferraro has advised that the authorized transfer has not been completed, although an Appellate District Court has decreed in his favor. The case has been remanded to the Superior Court to determine how the contract between Mr. Bird and himself is to be specifically enforced. The time involved in the next step of the court's action is unknown.
