SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

California Manufacturers Association (CMA) filed a petition for stay of order and reconsideration of Decision No. 82219 on December 14, 1973. The petition requested that: (1) the Commission issue its order staying the effective date of Decision 82219; (2) the Commission immediately reconsider the levels of rates in Items 507, 509, 509.5 and 520 of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (MRT 2) and suspend the application of these tariff rates on an indefinite basis; (3) the Commission also reconsider the levels of rates for specific commodities which are based upon Item 507 of MRT 2 and suspend the application of such rates on an indefinite basis; (4) the Commission issue its timely order to maintain the effective date for the unchallenged tariff items covered by Decision 82219;

and (5) the Commission recalculate the assailed rates in Items 507, 509, 509.5 and 520 of MRT 2 and related commodity rate items to conform to its Finding No. 14 in Decision 82219 and publish such rates at a later date.

Section 1733 of the Public Utilities Code provides that:
"Any application for rehearing made 10 days or more before the
effective date of the order as to which a rehearing is sought, shall
be either granted or denied before the effective date, or the order
shall stand suspended until the application is granted or denied."
The petition filed by CMA is not a petition for rehearing. Consequently, it does not stay the effectiveness of Decision No. 82219
as a matter of law, even though the petition was filed 10 days before
the order will become effective.

The truckload rates established by Decision 82219 in Items 507 and 508 of MRT 2, were erroneously calculated on the basis 65 62, 61, 60, 55, 50, 45 and 40 percent of the Class 100 scale, minimum weight 20,000 lbs., for Classes 45, 40, 37½, 35, 35.1, 35.2, 35.3 and 35.4, respectively. Such calculations did not give recognition to the hold downs in the truckload rate levels in effect pursuant to Decision 81337. It was not intended to alter the current rate relationships by Decision 82219. The tariff changes ordered herein will maintain these rate relationships. These tariff adjustments will conform to the request of CMA. Related adjustments in Minimum Rate Tariffs lB, 9B and 19 will also be made herein. In these circumstances, the petition for stay of order and reconsideration of Decision 82219 will be denied.

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for stay of order and reconsideration of Decision No. 32219 filed by the California Manufacturers Association on December 14, 1973, is denied.

Tariff publications of common carriers shall be made effective not earlier than January 1, 1974, on one day's notice to the Commission and to the public. 6. In all other respects Decisions Nos. 65834, 31606, 67766 and 41363, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect. DELAYS TO EQUIPMENT ON WHOLE GRAIN (See Note)

- Definitions
- (a) Actual placement. By actual placement is meant the placing of carrier's equipment at the site designated by consignor or consignee for loading or unloading.
- (b) Constructive placement. By constructive placement is meant the holding of a unit of carrier's equipment at a place or site other than the designated loading or un-loading place or site due to the inability of consignor or consignee to accept for actual placement the unit of carrier's equipment after its tender for actual placement by the carrier. Constructive placement of equipment for purpose of loading or unloading shall not commonce prior to the time specified in consignor's or consignee's oral or written equipment order, or at any time other than normal business days between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M. (the lunch hour between 12:00 noon and 1:00 P.M. excepted) Monday through Friday.
- (c) Unit of equipment. By unit of equipment is meant a motor truck trailer, or semitrailer, exclusive of motor tractor.

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- (a) A period of four (4) hours will be allowed on each unit of equipment between constructive placement and time equipment has actually completed loading or unloading.
- (b) The provisions of this item shall not apply in connection with the actual place ment of units of equipment under agreement with the consignor or consignee for loading by the consignor or unloading by the consignee, when such agreement is recorded on the shipping document.
- 3. Demurrage on Equipment Held After Free Time Has Elapsed
 A charge of 3 cents per 100 pounds will be made by the carrier on all shipments on
 all equipment unloaded or loaded after the free time has clapsed.
- Provisions of Item 145 (Charges For Accessorial Services or Delays) of this tariff will not apply.

NOTE .-- Applies only on shipments of Whole Grain, in bags, subject to minimum weights of 10,000 pounds or more.

DELAYS TO EQUIPMENT ON LUMBER
