SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 82156 dated November 20, 1973 in the above-entitled matter, the Commission, among other things, authorized Vern E. Dacus and Ethel F. Dacus to transfer their water system to Walter N. Knudsen. Inadvertently, no authority was granted in said decision for the execution and delivery of a proposed Deed of Trust and a Security Agreement as sought in the application.

The Commission reaffirms its findings in Decision No. 82156 and further finds that execution and delivery of the proposed Deed of Trust and the Security Agreement would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that Walter N. Knudsen may execute and deliver a Deed of Trust and a Security Agreement, which documents shall be in substantially the same form as those filed in this proceeding as Exhibit E and Exhibit F, respectively.
