ORDER EXTENDING VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

By Decision No. 80819, dated December 12, 1972, in the above proceeding, Allan L. Wenger, holding authority to serve points in San Mateo County as a cement carrier, was authorized to suspend his operations until December 1, 1973.

Mr. Wenger informed us by letter, received November 27, 1973, that he expects his financial problems to be resolved within the next six months.

He requests that the period of voluntary suspension be further extended.

After consideration, the Commission finds that to grant the request would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Ordering Paragraph No. 6 of Decision No. 80819, supra, is amended to read:
 - "6. The authority to suspend operations granted herein shall expire on July 1, 1974, or upon earlier resumption of operations which may be effected upon compliance with Ordering Paragraphs 3, 4 and 5."

in place and stead of present Ordering Paragraph No. 6.

- 2. Allan L. Wenger is placed on notice that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted him by Decision No. 78403, dated Harch 9, 1971, in Application No. 51839, is hereby revoked effective July 1, 1974, unless on or before such date, carrier resumes operations and meets all requirements contained in Decision No. 80819 for resumption of operations.
- 3. In all other respects the provisions of Decision No. 80819 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
