ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

By an order of suspension and investigation, issued September 12, 1973, certain tariff sheets of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, filed under Advice Letter No. 11120, were suspended to and including January 14, 1974, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission. It appears that conclusion of the matter may not be accomplished by January 14, 1974, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of the tariff sheets filed under respondent's Advice Letter No. 11120 are hereby suspended, as provided by statute, for an additional period of six months to and including July 14, 1974, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.
