ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 50729, dated November 3, 1954, in the above proceeding, Gene W. East, an individual, doing business as Vacuum Truck Service, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a petroleum irregular route carrier.

The certificate authorized the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in vacuum type or pump type tank trucks and tank trailers within a fifty mile radius of the City of Torrance.

Operations were authorized to be suspended for one year by Decision No. 79549, dated January 4, 1972, and an additional suspension was granted by Decision No. 80932, dated January 9, 1973, both in Application No. 35736.

The voluntary suspension authorization expired December 6, 1973 and the authority has not been reinstated.

Liability insurance required to be on file was canceled on December 6, 1971 and no new filing has been made.

A Commission representative was informed that Mr. East could not pay the fees to reinstate the operating authority nor could be purchase the necessary insurance.

Therefore, good cause appearing, the Commission finds that the authority granted to Gene W. East should be revoked. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted by Decision No. 50729, dated November 3, 1954, in Application No. 35736 is hereby revoked and that Local Freight Tariff, Cal. P.U.C. No. 5, Gene W. East, issuing officer, is hereby canceled, to become effective upon the effective date of this order.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of this order to be made by certified mail upon Gene W. East.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
