SECOND INTERIM OPINION

Pacific Southwest Airlines (PSA), Air California, Inc. (Air Cal), Golden West Airlines, Inc. (GWA), Western Air Lines, Inc. (Western), and Swift Aire Lines, Inc. (Swift) seek immediate authority to increase their air fares to compensate for recent expense increases incurred by them for aircraft fuel.

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The applications and amendments generally allege as follows: Increases in fuel costs have amounted to at least 30 percent since mid-1973. The increases were essentially caused by escalation in the posted prices of crude oil to the applicants' fuel suppliers which resulted in increases in charges by the suppliers to the applicants. The increases in aviation fuel prices are in compliance with the Federal Cost of Living Council's Phase IV regulations and will not be eliminated or decreased in the foreseeable future.

Decision No. 82280 dated December 18, 1973 in Application No. 54387 authorized PSA to increase its passenger fares by 23 cents per passenger on an interim basis pending hearing. Consolidated public hearing is scheduled for February 19, 1974 in Case No. 9646 and all applications filed by air common carriers seeking increased fares to offset fuel cost increases.

Interim increases of 23 cents per passenger were also granted Air Cal, Decision No. 82353; GWA, Decision No. 82355; and Western, Decision No. 82352; all dated January 15, 1974.

Latest amendments filed allege that the applicants experienced further fuel increases since early January which are not covered by the above interim fare increase of 23 cents.

It appears, and we so find, that the applicants have incurred an umprecedented increase in their aviation fuel costs within the last six months resulting from the worldwide energy crisis and pricing policies permitted by the Federal Cost of Living Council; that such fuel cost increases are of such magnitude as to impair applicants' operations unless an immediate revenue increase is authorized to offset such fuel cost increases; that PSA is the fare-setting (low cost)

Both PSA and Air Cal filed amendments seeking substitution of higher fares than originally requested. PSA seeks an increase of 70 cents in its IAX-SFO and related fares, in lieu of the interim increase of 23 cents; Air Cal seeks an increase of 72 cents in lieu of the original request of 25 cents.

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carrier in the markets served by the appendix A hereto pending hearing. CWA ments for further fare increases due to the 23 cents per passenger fare increases is less than their original requests, and distinct of the contract of the co

carrier in the markets served by the applicants; and that PSA should be authorized to establish the proposed increased fares set forth in Appendix A hereto pending hearing. GWA and Western did not file amendments for further fare increases due to increased fuel cost; however, the 23 cents per passenger fare increase granted on January 15, 1974 is less than their original requests, and we find that an immediate additional interim increase not exceeding the amount per passenger granted to PSA herein is justified pending further action of the Commission. Swift filed its application on January 14, 1974. An increase to the level authorized herein to PSA is also justified with respect to Swift.

SECOND INTERIM ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Pacific Southwest Airlines, Air California, Inc., Golden West Airlines, Inc., Western Air Lines, Inc., and Swift Aire Lines, Inc. are authorized to establish the proposed increased fares set forth in Appendices A, B, C, D, and E hereto, respectively.
- 2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed on or after the effective date of this order and may be made effective on five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.
