ORDER OF DISMISSAL

California Dump Truck Owners Association seeks an increase in the hourly rates contained in Minimum Rate Tariffs 7 and 17-A. The rates sought to be increased were considered in Case No. 5437, Order Setting Hearing 213. Decisions Nos. 82061 and 82062 issued October 30, 1973 in the above hearing were stayed. Decision No. 82325 dated January 8, 1974 modified said decisions and granted rehearing limited to certain specified issues. By operation of law, Decisions Nos. 82061 and 82062 became effective January 8, 1974.

In view of the above, Petition No. 232 is now moot and should be dismissed.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Petition for Modification No. 232 in Case No. 5437 is dismissed with prejudice.
