## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 82426 issued today in Case No. 5432 (OSH 700) found that the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariffs 2 and 14-A should be amended with respect to rates for the transportation of salt (sodium chloride) in bulk and that the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 14-A should be amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 14-A (Appendix A to Decision No. 67397, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 8, 1974, Eighth Revised Page 31-B, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 67397, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.

3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than March 8, 1974.

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4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and shorthaul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects, Decision No. 67397, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
