Decision No. 82443



BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of PLAZA APARTMENTS, an Illinois Limited Partnership Trust, doing business as SHELTER CREEK APARTMENTS, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a Passenger Stage Corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code between San Bruno and Daly City in San Mateo County.

Application No. 54492 (Filed December 10, 1973)

QPINION

Plaza Apartments, dba Shelter Creek Apartments, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide passenger stage service between the Shelter Creek Apartments, 701 Shelter Creek Lane, San Bruno, on the one hand, and the Bay Area Rapid Transit District (B.A.R.T.D.) station on Knowles Avenue in Daly City, on the other hand.

Applicant alleges that the Shelter Creek Apartments consist of some 1,300 units, with about 2,300 residents, and that it has received numerous requests from the tenants to provide a bus for transportation between the apartments and the Daly City BARTD station. Applicant proposes to provide such transportation for a 75¢ per capita fare. Applicant states that it owns a 1951 bus capable of seating 55 passengers and that it will acquire such additional equipment as may be necessary.

Copies of the application were served on the County of San Mateo, the Cities of San Bruno, Daly City and San Mateo, and Llso upon Greyhound Lines-West, Airportransit of California, Northgate Transit and South San Francisco Transit Service.

No protests have been received.

After consideration the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the

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application. We further find with reasonable certainty that the project involved in this proceeding will not have a significant effect on the environment. A public hearing is not necessary.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Plaza Apartments, doing business as Shelter Creek Apartments, to operate as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, between the points and over the route set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, subject to the following restrictions:

> (a) Service shall be provided only between the Shelter Creek Apartments, 701 Shelter Creek Drive, San Bruno, on the one hand, and the Bay Area Rapid Transit District Station on Knowles Avenue in Daly City, on the other hand.

(b) Other than the transportation of personal baggage accompanying a passenger, no additional transportation service, including the transportation of express matter, shall be performed.

2. In providing service pursuant to the authority granted by this order, applicant shall comply with the following service regulations. Failure so to do may result in a cancellation of the authority.

> (a) Within thirty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate granted. Applicant is placed on notice that if it accepts the certificate it will be required, among other things, to comply with the safety rules of the California Highway Patrol, the rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98-Series and the insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 101-Series.

(b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.

(c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the authorized service.

(d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79-Series and 98-Series.

(e) Applicant shall maintain its accounting records on a calendar year basis in conformance with the applicable Uniform System of Accounts or Chart of Accounts as prescribed or adopted by this Commission and shall file with the Commission, on or before March 31 of each year, an annual report of their operations in such form, content, and number of copies as the Commission, from time to time, shall prescribe.

SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

Plaza Apartments, dba Shelter Creek Apartments, by the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport passengers and their baggage between the Shelter Creek Apartments, 701 Shelter Creek Drive, San Bruno, on the one hand, and the Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BARTD) station on Knowles Avenue in Daly City, on the other hand, over and along the route hereinafter described, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify said route at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- (a) Motor vehicles may be turned at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, 22 at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, in accordance with local traffic regulations.
- (b) Service shall be provided only between the Shelter Creek Apartments and the Daly City BARTD Station.
- (c) Other than the transportation of personal baggage accompanying a passenger, no additional transportation service, including the transportation of express matter, shall be performed.

SECTION 2. ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Route 1. Commencing at the Shelter Creek Apartments, 701 Shelter Creek Drive, San Bruno, thence via Shelter Creek Drive, San Bruno Avenue, Junipero Serra Freeway (I-280), Junipero Serra Blvd; Knowles Avenue, and De Long to termination at the Bay Area Rapid Transit District Station on Knowles Avenue in Daly City. Return via the same route except delete the underlined.
