ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 81819 dated August 28, 1973 in this proceeding authorized applicant to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities requiring refrigeration or temperature control between various points and places in California. Ordering Paragraph 2(a) of the decision required that applicant establish the authorized service and file tariffs in triplicate with the Commission by January 15, 1974. By letter dated January 15, 1974, applicant's attorney has advised the Commission that, due to circumstances beyond its control, applicant was unable to prepare the necessary documentation in time to meet this requirement and requests an extension of time.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The time period specified in Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 81819 within which applicant shall commence service and file tariffs is extended to March 1, 1974.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 81819 shall remain in full force and effect.
