#### SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff 10 (MRT 10) provides minimum rates and rules for the transportation of cement and related commodities by highway carriers between points in the State of California. By Decision No. 82213, dated December 4, 1973, in this proceeding certain rates in MRT 10 were adjusted.

It has come to the Commission's attention that one of the adjusted mileage rates does not reflect the intent of Decision No. 82213.1

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the necessary correction should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that MRT 10 should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

Minimum Rate Tariff 10 (Appendix A to Decision No. 44633, 1. as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective February 23, 1974, Seventh Revised Page 12-A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

<sup>1</sup> The 400-mile rate of 60<sup>k</sup> cents per 100 pounds in Item 205 of MRT 10 for shipments in packages should be 623 cents per 100 pounds.

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2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 44633, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the increase necessary to conform with the further adjustment ordered herein.

3. Common carriers maintaining rates on a level other than the minimum rates for transportation for which rates are prescribed in Minimum Rate Tariff 10 are authorized to increase their 400-mile rates by the same amount authorized by this decision for the Minimum Rate Tariff 10 rate involved herein.

4. Common carriers maintaining rates on the same level as Minimum Rate Tariff 10 rates for the transportation of commodities and/or for transportation not subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 10 are authorized to increase their 400-mile rates by the same amount authorized by this decision for the Minimum Rate Tariff 10 rate involved herein.

5. Common carriers maintaining rates at levels other than the minimum rates for the transportation of commodities and/or for transportation not subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 10 are authorized to increase their 400-mile rates by the same amount authorized by this decision for the Minimum Rate Tariff 10 rate involved herein.

6. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than February 23, 1974.

7. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rate authorized by this order, are authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now

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maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rate published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

8. In all other respects Decision No. 44633, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
