SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No.82486 entered today in Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification 774) et al. found that the provisions regarding pool shipments should be amended in Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 9-B and 19 and that the amendments of these tariffs should be accomplished by a separate order in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No. 65834, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein

to become effective March 9, 1974, Fourteenth Revised Page 26, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B (Appendix A of Decision No. 67766, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective March 9, 1974, Fourth Revised Page 8 and Thirteenth Revised Page 31, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

3. Minimum Rate Tariff 19 (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective March 9, 1974, Thirtieth Revised Page 23, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

4. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision Nos. 41363, 65834 and 67766, as amended, are directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustment ordered by this by this decision.

5. Tariff publications required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public; such tariff publications as are required shall be made effective not later than March 9, 1974; and as to tariff publications which are authorized but not required, the authority shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order.

6. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code

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to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

7. In all other respects Decisions Nos. 41363, 65834 and 67766, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


