ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Granzotto Trucking Co., Inc. (Granzotto), a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility ware-houseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Walnut Creek.

Annual reports filed with the Commission by Granzotto for the years, 1967 through 1972, indicate that the corporation did not devote any warehouse floor space to public utility storage at Walnut Creek.

Farry N. Granzotto has informed the Commission by letter that the floor space involved has been, and is at present, donated to the Walnut Creek Host Lions Club and the corporation is no longer involved in public warehousing. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Granzotto Trucking Co., Inc., a corporation, as determined by the Commission's order dated August 16, 1960, in Case No. 6840, is hereby revoked.

2. Granzotto Trucking Co., Inc., Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Granzotto Trucking Co., Inc., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
