ORDER EXTENDING EXPIRATION DATE

In Decision No. 81831 dated September 5, 1973 we authorized Bulk Transportation to charge less than the applicable minimum rates for the transportation of nutmeats, spoiled or wormy, unfit for human consumption, in bulk, for the account of Liberty Vegetable Oil Company on an interim basis for a period of six months from the date of that decision. Subsequent to that decision a hearing was held on the matter at which time the parties agreed that a petition to establish an exception rating on the subject commodity would better serve applicant's and the shipper's desired result, and the hearing was recessed pending the filing and ultimate outcome of such petition. The petition was filed as Petition for Modification No. 788 in Case No. 5432 and is now pending. The Commission concludes that the expiration date in Decision No. 81831 should be extended until Petition for Modification No. 788 in Case No. 5432 is finally determined.

IT IS ORDERED that the expiration date in Decision No. 81831 is extended until Petition for Modification No. 788 in Case No. 5432 is finally determined, at which time said decision is canceled.
