SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 82085 dated November 7, 1973 in Case No. 9557 fined respondent Evan E. Oakley \$4,731.92 in undercharges plus a punitive fine of \$500.00. Oakley paid \$1,666.72 of the undercharge fine on January 21, 1974, and the balance of \$3,065.20 was remitted to the Commission on February 1, 1974. Oakley has requested by letter that he be authorized to pay the \$500 punitive fine in five equal monthly installments. The Transportation Division does not oppose this request.

IT IS ORDERED that the punitive fine of \$500 imposed by Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 82085 may be paid in five equal monthly installments, \$100 to be paid on or before March 25, 1974 and \$100 to be paid on or before the fifteenth day of each of the four succeeding months.

In all other respects Decision No. 82085 shall remain in full force and effect.
