ORDER OF MODIFICATION

On January 29, 1974 the Commission issued its Decision No. 82390 ordering the establishment of a number of one-way extended area service and optional calling measured service routes in the Modesto area. Inadvertently, optional calling measured service was not ordered to be established from the Knights Ferry exchange to the Modesto exchange as proposed.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 82390 is modified as follows:

1. Continental Telephone Company of California (Continental) and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific) shall immediately undertake all necessary action to initiate within twenty-four months of the effective date of this order one-way extended area service (1-EAS) from the Escalon, Oakdale, Turlock, Waterford Main District Area, and Ripon exchanges to the Modesto exchange, and from the Knights Ferry exchange to the Oakdale exchange. Further, optional calling measured service (OCMS) shall be initiated within twenty-four months of the effective date of this order from the Modesto exchange to the Escalon, Oakdale, Turlock, Waterford Main District Area, Ripon, and Knights Ferry exchanges, from the Oakdale exchange to the Knights Ferry exchange, and from the Knights Ferry exchange to the Modesto exchange.

The rate increments proposed in Exhibit No. 5, Exhibit No. 7, and on page 2 of Exhibit No. 9 in these proceedings are hereby authorized to be added for a period of twenty-four months to base rates of the Modesto, Escalon, Oakdale, Turlock, Waterford Main District Area, Knights Ferry, and Ripon exchanges when the services herein ordered are initiated.
