O P I N I O N

George Gardner, Jr. and Lois B. Gardner, husband and wife doing business as George Gardner Water Company, seek authority to sell and transfer their water system properties to Yucaipa Valley County Water District.

After consideration we find that:

1. By Decision No. 77653, dated August 25, 1970, in Application No. 52012, the Commission authorized George Gardner, Jr. to sell and transfer to Calimesa Water District the assets of the water system known as George Gardner Water Company.
2. The parties did not consummate the transaction contemplated by said Decision No. 77653.
3. Yucaipa Valley County Water District is successor-in-interest to Calimesa Water District.
4. With reasonable certainty the project involved in this proceeding will not have a significant effect on the environment.

5. The proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest.

On the basis of the foregoing findings we conclude that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.


O R D E R


IT IS ORDERED that George Gardner, Jr. and Lois B. Gardner may sell and transfer their water system properties to Yucaipa Valley County Water District.


