SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No.82619 entered today in Case No. 5436 (Petition 159) the Commission ordered a cost offset increase of approximately 14 percent in the rates named in Minimum Rate Tariff 6-B governing the highway transportation of bulk petroleum products within California. This cost offset rate adjustment reflects fuel cost increases previously offset by a 3 percent interim surcharge supplement and order issued in this proceeding by Decision No. 82453 dated February 5, 1974. Application of the 3 percent interim surcharge supplement and order to charges resulting under the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 6-B should, therefore, be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The 3 percent interim surcharge supplement and order currently applicable to charges resulting from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 6-B is cancelled effective March 30, 1974.
- 2. Minimum Rate Tariff 6-B (Appendix A of Decision No. 82350, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 30, 1974, Supplement 1, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 3. In all other respects Decision No. 82350, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
