ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

West Coast Checkerboard Elevator Company, a corporation, possesses an operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Stockton.

West Coast Checkerboard Elevator Company has not filed with the Commission annual reports since 1970. Moreover, the corporation has informed the Commission by letter that its public warehouse operation was discontinued in April of 1971.

West Coast Checkerboard Elevator Company not having filed annual reports as required by Section 584 of the Public Utilities Code and apparently no longer operating as a public utility warehouseman, the Commission finds that such circumstances constitute good cause for revocation of the certificate and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by West Coast Checkerboard Elevator Company, a corporation, as stated in Decision No. 69259, dated June 22, 1965, in Application No. 47616 is hereby revoked.


2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of West Coast Checkerboard Elevator Company from the involved tariff of California Warehouse Tariff Bureau on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective


date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon West Coast Checkerboard Elevator Company or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.


The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof unless, before such effective date, there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
