ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

Decision No. 82243 dated December 7, 1973 in this proceeding granted the petition of The Standard Register Company (Pacific Region) for investigation and suspension of Items 495.1 and 495.2 of Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau Tariff 274, ICC 1415, issued by A. Y. Graham, Tariff Publishing Officer.<sup>1/</sup> That decision also ordered that Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau shall maintain the rates named in Items 495.1 and 495.2 of Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau Tariff 274 until April 11, 1974 unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

PAPER ARTICLES, viz.:

CARDS or TICKETS, autographic, cash register, time register or accounting, computing, data-processing or weighing machines, printed or not printed.

PAPER, AUTOGRAPHIC REGISTER, CASH REGISTER, COMPUTING MACHINE or TICKET ISSUING MACHINE, PLAIN or RULED, printed or not printed in boxes. (See Note 1)

Twentieth Revised Page 47-B of Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau Tariff 274 filed with the Commission on March 8, 1974 to become effective April 11, 1974 reestablishes the rates cancelled by the tariff filing under suspension. The reestablishment of the rates in question makes the issues in this proceeding moot; therefore, the investigation ordered in Decision No. 82243 should be terminated and the proceeding should be discontinued.
