## ORDER OF DTSMTSSAI

Union Iranspertation Co., a California corporation, requests authority to sell and transfer, and Westem Cement Iransport, Inc. requests authority to purchase and acquire, a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a cement carrier.

The certiffcate is prescriptive in nature and as set forth in. Comission Resolution No. 13821, Sub. No. 19 dated June 23, 1954 in Application No. 46450 authorizes the transportation of shipments of cement to and within the councies of El Dorado, Placer, and Sacramento. The agreed cash consiceration is $\$ 1,500$.

Applicant purchaser is engaged in the transportation of cenent pursuant to a cement contract carrier pemit which covers 16 counties inclucieg El Dorado and Plecer. It maintains its principal place of business in Hayward and as of Scptember 30, 1973 indicated $a$ zet worth in the axomont of $\$ 28,880$.

Section 3542.1 of the Rubiic Ueilities Cocle prohibits a person or corporation from engaging in transportation both as a cement carrier and as a cenent contract carrier. This prohibition applies whether or not the comeles authorized by the certificate are different from those authorized by the permit. The law prehibits us Erom granting this appifcation. (See Re Leonard A. Kinzel (1967) 66 CTUC 816.)

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 54498 is dismissed.
