ORDER DENYING REHEARING AND
AMENDING DECISION NO. 82426

Petitions for rehearing of Decision No. 82426 dated February 5, 1974 having been filed by the California Trucking Association (CTA), Bulk Freightways (Bulk) and Tom Utsuki Trucking Co., Inc. (Utsuki), and the Commission having considered each and every allegation therein and being of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Rehearing of Decision No. 82426 is denied.
2. At page 3, mimeo, of Decision No. 82426, the first full paragraph is amended to read as follows:

"As indicated in Decision No. 80625, Bulk Freightways (Bulk) operates pneumatic hopper equipment for the transportation of bulk salt for three shippers located in Los Angeles County, and Tom Utsuki Trucking, Inc. (Utsuki) operates dump truck and transfer-trailer equipment for transportation of bulk salt for the same shippers. Bulk operates under the hourly rates in MRT 15. Utsuki charges hourly rates under a rate deviation authority granted in Decision No. 79708 dated February 15, 1972 in Application No. 52634.

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West Coast Warehouse Co. charges hourly rates under a rate deviation authority granted in Decision No. 80406 dated August 29, 1972 in Application No. 53182 and continued under Resolution SDD-86 adopted November 7, 1973. These carriers are the only carriers known to be engaged in the handling of bulk salt from origins in Los Angeles County at this time."

3. Footnote 1 on said page is deleted.

4. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D of Decision No. 31606 as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective April 13, 1974, Supplement 112 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

5. Minimum Rate Tariff 14-A (Appendix A to Decision No. 67397, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective April 13, 1974, Supplement 8 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

6. Tariff publications required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order, on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public; such tariff publications as are required shall be made effective not later than April 13, 1974; and as to tariff publications which are authorized but not required, the authority shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order.

7. In all other respects, Decisions Nos. 31606 and 67397, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
