## SUPPLEMENTAL SECOND INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff 10 (MRT 10) provides minimum rates and rules for the transportation of coment and related commodities by highway carriers between points in the State of California. By Decision No. 82624, dated March 19, 1974, in this proceeding certain rates in MRT 10 were adjusted.

It has come to the Commission's attention that the rates for the transportation of cement between points in California for distances of 30 miles or less do not reflect the intent of Decision No. 82624.1

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the necessary corrections should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that MRT 10 should be amended accordingly.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 10 (Appendix A to Decision No. 44633, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective April 27, 1974, Ninth Revised Page 12-A and Seventh

The rates in question are set forth in Items Nos. 205 and 210 of IRT 10.

effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

- 7. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized by this order, are authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 8. In all other respects Decision No. 44633, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
