SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 82713, dated April 9, 1974, in the above application, Ted Peters Trucking Company, Inc., a California corporation, was granted an extension of its highway common carrier authority.

An in-lieu certificate was issued which brought together its original authority and the extended portion.

In transcribing the old route numbers on Appendix A of said decision a junction was incorrectly identified.

After consideration the Commission finds that the necessary correction should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Decision No. 82713, supra, should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 82713, is amended by incorporating First Revised Page 1, attached hereto, in revision of Original Page 1.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 82713, remains in full force and effect.

Ted Peters Trucking Company, Inc., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to conduct operations as a highway common carrier as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code for the transportation of general commodities:

FROM, TO AND BETWEEN;

A. All points and places on or within 20 miles of:

1. Interstate Highway 80 between San Francisco and Roseville.
2. State Highway 99 between Sacramento and its junction with Interstate Highway 5 near Wheeler Ridge; Interstate Highway 5 between its junction with State Highway 99 and the City of Los Angeles; Interstate Highway 10 between the City of Los Angeles and Redlands.
3. Interstate Highway 580 between San Francisco and its junction with Interstate Highway 205 near the Alameda-San Joaquin County Line; Interstate Highway 205 between its junction with Interstate Highway 580 and its junction with Interstate Highway 5; Interstate Highway 5 between its junction with Interstate Highway 205 and Stockton.
4. State Highway 4 between its junction with Interstate Highway 80, near Pinole, and Stockton.
5. State Highway 33 between Tracy and Maricopa.
