FINAL ORDER

By Decision No. 82112 dated November 13, 1973, Bayview Trucking, Inc. was granted interim authority to transport wheels, iron or steel, requiring or suitable for use with tires, without tires, in cartons, from Torrance to Benicia in truckload lots of not less than 45,000 pounds per unit of equipment for the account of E-T Industries, Inc., Benicia, at rates less than the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (MRT 2). The interim authority was granted for a period of six months and will expire May 13, 1974.

No protest to the application has been received and a public hearing does not appear to be necessary. The Commission finds that the proposed rates are reasonable for the transportation to be performed, and therefore concludes that the authority to deviate from MRT 2 as set forth in Decision No. 82112 should be continued for a period of one year.
