Investigation on the Commission's own motion into warehouse operative rights of LACEY MILLING COMPANY, a corporation.

Case No. 6832

ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Lacey Milling Company, a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Hanford.

Raymond E. Wiltshire, Jr., attorney for the warehouseman, has informed the Commission by letter that Lacey Milling Company did not hold itself out to the public as a warehouse facility in 1972 and has not done so since that time. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Lacey Milling Company, a corporation, as determined by the Commission's order dated August 16, 1960 in Case No. 6832 is hereby revoked.
- 2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the tariff of Lacey Milling Company on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to

the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause accopy of this order to be made upon Lacey Millia a certified copy thereof to it at its last known

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Lacey Milling Company or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent, and Raymond E. Wiltshire, Jr., P. O. Box 989, Hanford, CA 93230.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
