## OPINION AND ORDER

By Decisions Nos. 82104 and 82105 dated November 13, 1973 applicant was granted interim authority for six months to deviate from the minimum rates in Minimum Rate Tariff 2.

The interim authority provided that applicant should file financial data so that a determination could be made as to whether the transportation for which the authority was granted is compensatory. On March 13, 1974 the requested financial data were filed. They indicate that the transportation is compensatory.

After consideration the Commission finds and concludes that the authority granted by Decisions Nos. 82104 and 82105 should be extended for one year.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted by Decisions Nos. 82104 and 82105 is extended to one year after the effective date of this order.
