ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 82282 dated January 3, 1974, applicant was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier and within 120 days of the effective date of said order was required to file tariffs with the Commission. However, because of difficulties encountered in relating the tariff provisions with applicant's computer billing system, completion of the tariffs has been delayed, and applicant requests an extension of 45 days to comply with the order.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the time within which to comply with the tariff filing requirements of Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 82282 is hereby extended for forty-five days.
