<u>OPINION</u>

Carr Trucking, Inc. requests authority to discontinue service as a highway common carrier.

Applicant is presently authorized to conduct operations as a permitted carrier, and as a certificated carrier pursuant to Decision No. 80279 dated July 18, 1972 in Application No. 53408, which authorized the transportation of general commodities between points within the area from San Luis Obispo on the north and the Los Angeles County area on the south.

It is alleged that applicant has experienced insurmountable financial difficulties; that Mr. James Carr, applicant's president and sole stockholder, wishes to spend more time with his wife, who is seriously ill; and that arrangements have been made with other carriers for the continuation of transportation service to applicant's customers.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service as a highway common carrier and that the proposed discontinuance of service would not have an adverse effect upon the public. A public hearing is not necessary.

<u>O R D E R</u>

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Carr Trucking, Inc. is hereby authorized to discontinue service as a highway common carrier and the operating authority granted by Decision No. 80279 dated July 18, 1972 in Application No. 53408 is hereby revoked.

2. The tariffs presently on file with the Commission in the name of applicant are hereby canceled.
