FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Hain Trucking Co., Inc., a corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. By the Certificate of Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation duly filed with the Secretary of State of California on February 6, 1974, Hain Trucking Co., Inc. changed its corporate name to M.A.P., Inc. A request for change of corporate name having been filed by Hain Trucking Co., Inc., its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing;

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity transferred to Hain Trucking Co., Inc. by Decision No. 63970, in Application No. 44493, is amended by substituting the name "M.A.P., Inc." in the place and stead of "Hain Trucking Co., Inc."

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2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, M.A.P., Inc. shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
