ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This application was filed on September 11, 1973. It was protested on October 5, 1973 and scheduled for hearing on January 24, 1974 in Los Angeles. Counsel for applicant withdrew on January 9, 1974. A letter dated January 14, 1974 was mailed to applicant's last address. No reply was ever received, although another attorney advised he was representing applicant by a letter dated January 22, 1974 and requested that a 120-day continuance be authorized. Counsel was advised by letter on February 27, 1974 that new hearing dates should be selected. No reply was received and on April 2, 1974 a notice was sent to warn that Application No. 54319 would be dismissed in May unless scheduled for hearing. No reply has been received and there has been no request to schedule Application No. 54319 for hearing.

The Commission therefore finds and concludes that
Application No. 54319 should be dismissed for want of prosecution.
