## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decisions Nos. 82924 and 82928 dated May 29, 1974, in Cases Nos. 5432 and 7783 (Petitions for Modification Nos. 779 and 84) established revised rates in Minimum Rate Tariffs 2 and 15, respectively, for the transportation of property by highway carriers.

It has come to the Commission's attention that certain tariff items were not adjusted to reflect the intent of the aforementioned decisions.

The Class 50.1 260-mile rate in Item 506 of MRT 2 should read "100 cents" instead of "110 cents." The heading of Item 484 of MRT 15 should read "TRACTOR-GAS, 3-Axle" instead of "TRACTOR-DIESEL, 3-Axle."
