ORDER EXTENDING TIME

In a letter dated March 1, 1974, Mr. Edward McBride, the Operations Manager for Plaza Apartments, doing business as Shelter Creek Apartments, requested authority to extend the time from 120 days to 190 days that is required for compliance with a provision, Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 82443, dated February 5, 1974 in Application No. 54492.

Applicant stated that additional time was needed to recondition his present bus to comply with the safety standards of the California Highway Patrol. He also stated that the recent increased demand for commuter bus transportation has resulted in the need to purchase two additional buses. As a consequence, he stated that there will be a considerable delay since it is difficult to obtain additional buses because of energy crisis developments. The request should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that "one hundred twenty days" as contained in Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 82443 is amended to read "one hundred ninety days". All other provisions of Decision No. 82443 shall remain in full force and effect.
