ORDER REOPENING

By Decision No. 82112 dated November 13, 1973, Bayview Trucking, Inc. was granted interim authority to transport wheels, iron or steel, requiring or suitable for use with tires, without tires, in cartons, from Torrance to Benicia in truckload lots of not less than 45,000 pounds per unit of equipment for the account of E-T Industries, Inc., Benicia, at rates less than the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 2. By Decision No. 82851 dated May 7, 1974, the authority was extended to May 13, 1975. By letter dated May 9, 1974, California Trucking Association requests that the matter be set for public hearing.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 54301 is hereby reopened for public hearing. Decision No. 82851 remains in effect.
